*** By signing this application the applicant understands and agrees to the following conditions attached to the permit:**

1. I am voluntarily applying for a permit to undertake activities for an Agricultural Waste and Process Wastewater Irrigation System on the above located property.
2. I understand that plans and specifications shall be prepared in accordance with the criteria cited within USDA Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) conservation practice standards 442 (Sprinkler System) and 449 (Irrigation Water Management Plan) as well as any associated USDA NRCS Wisconsin practice standards and construction specifications.
3. I understand and will follow all existing state and local laws regarding animal waste and nutrient management.
4. I understand that construction activities shall not begin until a permit has been issued through the Kewaunee County Land & Water Conservation Department (LWCD).
5. I understand that I must submit and follow an approved Nutrient Management Plan (NRCS conservation standard 590) and Irrigation Water Management Plan (NRCS conservation standard 449).
6. I understand that I will not exceed manure application limits.
7. I understand that I will NOT apply any amount of human waste, septage or other restricted wastes.
8. I understand that I will abide by all relevant setback requirements of this Ordinance and NRCS Nutrient Management 590.
9. I understand that I shall provide all record keeping and retention requirements detailed in Chapter 37.10.
10. I understand that I must notify the LWCD of any changes to the originally permitted design plan and will not allow construction or irrigation activities to take place involving any proposed changes until a change-work order has been approved and documented by the LWCD.
11. I understand that chapter NR 216, Wis. Adm. Code requires that if more than one (1) acre of ground (43,560 sq. ft.) is disturbed for this project, construction activities can not begin until the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources has also issued a construction site storm water permit. I understand I am responsible for obtaining this permit.
12. I understand that after the LWCD has a properly completed permit application form, plans and specifications, and associated permit fees, the LWCD will issue the permit within thirty (30) calendar days of receipt.
13. I understand that "liquid manure" means manure with a solids content of less than 12% and "process wastewater", as per NR 243, Wis. Adm. Code, means wastewater from the production area directly or indirectly used in the operation of animal feeding operation that results from any or all of the following:
 - a. Spillage or overflow from animal or poultry watering systems
 - b. Washing, cleaning, or flushing pens, barns, manure pits or other animal feeding operation facilities
 - c. Direct contact swimming, washing or spray cooling of animals or dust control.
 - d. Water that comes into contact with any raw material or animal byproducts including manure, feed, milk, eggs or bedding.
14. I understand that any person who violates, neglects, or refuses to comply with or resists the enforcement of any provision of the Kewaunee County Agricultural Waste & Process Wastewater Irrigation Ordinance shall be subject to a forfeiture of not less than \$2,500 nor more than \$10,000 plus costs of prosecution of each violation. An unlawful violation includes failure to comply with any standard of this ordinance or with any condition or qualification attached to the permit. Each day that a violation exists shall be a separate offense.
