REDCEDAR EASTERN

JUNIPERUS VIRGINIANA

Height 30 – 40'

Spread 8 – 20'

Zone 3 – 9

Habit Pyramidal

Foliage MEDIUM GREEN

Fall Color Insignificant

Densely pyramidal when young, becoming slightly pendulous with age. Foliage is green to bluish-green turning bronze to deep green in winter. This very tolerant plant grows in full sun and well drained soils, but will tolerate poor dry sites. Useful as a windbreak, hedge or shelter belt planting. Growth rate is medium. Seed source: Wisconsin & Michigan.



DOUGLASFIR

PSEUDOTSUGA MENZIESII

Height	40 – 80'
Spread	12 – 20'
Zone	4 – 6
Habit	Narrow pyramid
Foliage	Bluish-green

An upright pyramidal form becoming more open with age. Needles are soft and bluish green. Grow in sun in moist, well drained soils. A handsome evergreen tree that makes a nice specimen, group planting or Christmas tree. We grow only non-coastal strains to ensure maximum hardiness. Seed source: Apache National Forest, Arizona.



FIR BALSAM

ABIES X BALSAM

Height	45 – 75'
Spread	20 – 25'
Zone	3 – 5
Habit	Narrow pyramidal becoming conical with age
Foliage	Shiny dark green
Fall Color	Shiny dark green

Glossy dark green needles with 2 white bands on the undersides. A fast growing plant that will grow in full sun or shade on cool, moist, soils. Specimens can grow in wet areas. Great Christmas or landscape tree.

The foliage is very fragrant. Seed source: Upper Michigan.



PINE WHITE

PINUS STROBUS

Height	50 – 80'
Spread	20 – 40'
Zone	3 – 8
Habit	Pyramidal
Foliage	Soft bluish-green
Fall Color	Soft bluish-green

A fast growing tree that has a pyramidal form when young. With age, trees become picturesque forming tufts of spaced branches that gives them a unique form. Needles are soft in clusters of five and green to bluish-green. Grow in full sun to partial shade on moist, well-drained soil. Avoid windy or exposed sites.

A beautiful Pine that is a great specimen, grouping or can be sheared into a hedge. Seed source: Upper Michigan.



LILAC DWARF KOREAN

SYRINGA MEYERI 'PALIBIN'

Height	4 – 5'
Spread	8 – 10'
Zone	3 – 7
Habit	Oval
Foliage	Green
Fall Color	Yellow-green

Korean lilac is a dense, rounded-oval, non-suckering, deciduous shrub which typically grows 4-8' tall with a spread of 6-10'. 'Palibin' is a compact, low-spreading cultivar which typically grows 4-5' tall with a spread of 5-7'. Pale pink, sweetly-fragrant single flowers arranged in dense, terminal clusters (panicles to 4" long) cover this shrub with a profuse bloom in late April to early May (St. Louis area). Elliptic-ovate, dark green leaves (to 1.5" long) are smaller than the species. No fall color. This shrub is sometime grafted to a 4' standard and sold as a small tree with a dense, rounded crown. Tree form typically matures to 8' tall. Easily grown in average, dry to medium, well-drained soil in full sun. Tolerates light shade, but best bloom is in full sun. Prefers organically rich, moist, slightly acidic to slightly alkaline soils. Needs good air circulation. Good tolerance for urban conditions. Prompt removal of faded flower panicles before seed set will increase the bloom in the following year. Prune as needed immediately after flowering. Effective as a specimen or massed. Shrub borders, foundations. Good screen or informal hedge for property lines.

Korean lilacs are generally more attractive than many other species of lilacs in summer due to their mildew-free foliage.

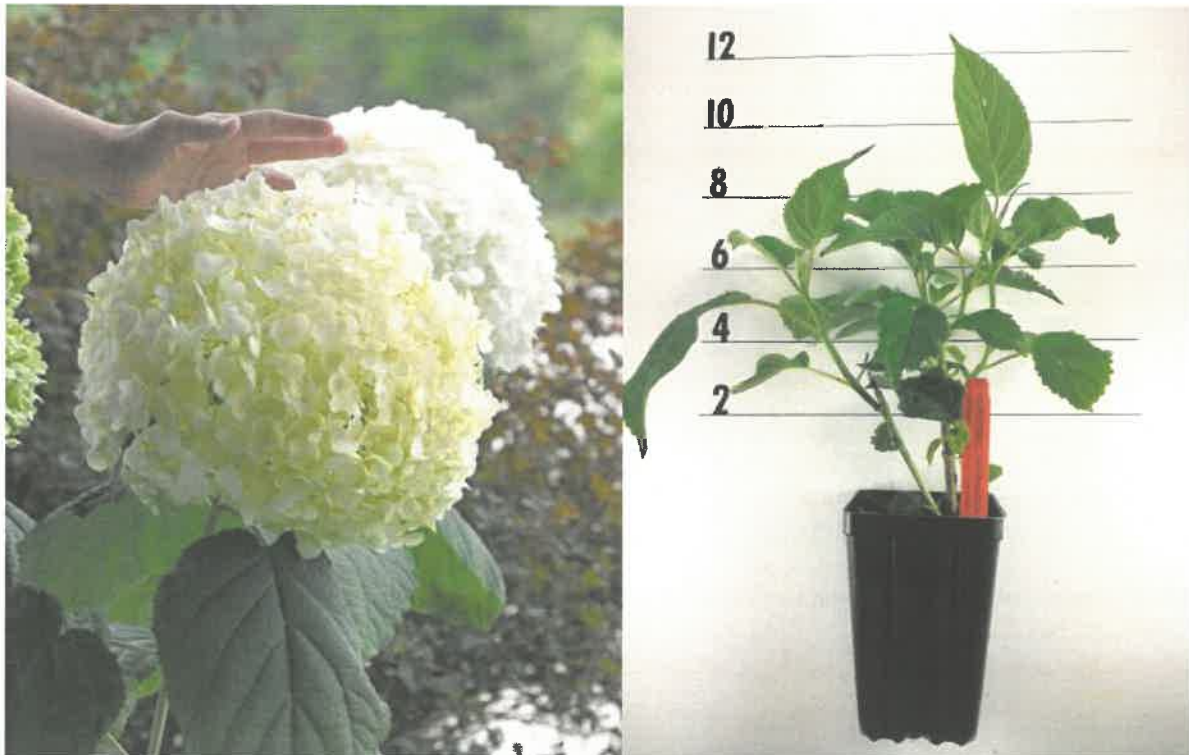


HYDRANGEA INCREDIBALL® SMOOTH 'PW'

An exciting **new hardy hydrangea** that **produces massive 12" blooms** that emerge lime green, change to pure snowy white and then fade to green, all season long. These immense 12" flowers are held upright atop massive, sturdy thick stems that prevent flopping even in inclement weather. Use in groupings or masses, perennial or shrub borders, specimen, winter gardens. **Attracts butterflies.**

Pink and white two-toned blooms!

A beautiful new hardy hydrangea with loads of bodacious blooms that emerge pure white and then turn bright pink from the bottom up. Flowers eventually age to a dark pink-red, and stay colorful for months. It looks a bit like classic Pinky Winky hydrangea, but with full, mophead flowers, and it blooms much earlier, too. Strong stems hold the flowers upright in the garden, and make it an excellent cut flower, too. **Blooms every year, no matter how harsh the winter was and provides 3+ months of flowers. Easy to maintain,** Zinfin Doll® is heat tolerant, requires part sun to full sun and average watering. These are shallow-rooted plants that really benefit from a 2-3" (5-7.6 cm) layer of mulch. Plan to cut these plants back by about one-third in early spring. This builds up a strong base while encouraging vigorous new growth to produce lots of blooms. Many uses include borders, containers, cut flower, dried flower, landscape, mass planting and focal point.



WEIGELA SONIC BLOOM® PINK 'PW'

This weigela variety boasts an explosion of color. Each tiny blossom appears hot pink with a deep pink throat. The blooms appear in May, clustered along the branches in such profusion of flowers that your shrub will at times appear to be nothing more than a mound of colorful blooms. As the flowers recede and re-bloom, you'll begin to notice the dramatic, dark green foliage that fills out the few spaces between the blossoms...which continue to re-bloom right up until the first frost. Sonic Bloom doesn't need deadheading, and provides its remarkable show from spring through fall with nothing needed from you. Sonic Bloom Pink Weigela will grow up to 5 feet in height with an equal spread. It's a very dense shrub with a mounded nature. Sonic Bloom is adaptable to a variety of soils, urban tolerant and long-lived. **A hardy shrub that works well in containers, as an ornamental hedge along an outbuilding, or even just planted singly for a strong accent in your yard.**
