The Kewaunee County Land and Water Conservation Department is continuing a comprehensive study on groundwater quality in Kewaunee County, funded through a Wisconsin Coastal Management Grant and a donation by Peninsula Pride Farms.

The purpose of this project is to (1) continue to understand the extent of nitrate and bacteriological contamination in the Silurian Dolomite aquifer, and (2) determine if / what progress has been made in Kewaunee County since the implementation of the new NR151 Silurian Dolomite Standards and Prohibitions.

We hope you will agree to assist this study by providing a water sample from you well. **All water analyses are free at no cost to you.**

You will receive a copy of your results after the water testing is complete. **All results will be confidential and only be presented in a way that does not identify individual homes.**
