

Promotion & Recreation Committee Minutes - June 12th, 2019

The meeting was called to order at 5:35 p.m. at the Kewaunee County Highway Department Conference Room by Chairman Scott Jahnke. Members present: Chairman Scott Jahnke, Supervisor Kim Kroll, Supervisor Thomas Cretney and Supervisor Cory Cochart. Supervisor Doug Doell arrived at 6:00 p.m.

Also present at the meeting: Dave Myers – Promotions & Recreation Director

Adoption of Agenda:

Supervisor Kroll made a motion to approve the June 12th, 2019 agenda and the May 14th minutes. This was seconded by Supervisor Cretney. All were in favor, motion carried unanimously.

Public Input: None

Discuss Ahnapee Trail Bridge and Algoma Parking Lot Projects with Action:

Dave explained the need to replace railing and decking on one of the trail bridges near Reckeberg Park. The Friends of the Ahnapee State Trail have pledged the matching funds to use with a grant and the Highway Department would be completing the project later this month. He also explained that the parking lot in Algoma has been approved and that project will be beginning soon.

Supervisor Cochart made a motion to approve the bridge project. Seconded by Supervisor Kroll. All in favor, motion carried unanimously.

Discuss ATV Park Erosion Control and Shelter Grants Projects with Action:

The committee was presented a resolution for grant funding for this project. Dave explained that the Baylake ATV club had already started on some of the trail reroutes involved with the plan developed by the Land & Water Conservation Department and the US Fish and Wildlife Service. They are planning to complete most of the project by late September if weather and field conditions cooperate.

Supervisor Cochart made a motion to approve the Grant Resolution. Seconded by Supervisor Kroll. All in favor, motion carried unanimously.

Discuss Bruemmer Park Master Plan Progress:

Dave updated the committee as to upcoming projects that include a new deer and goat shelter building and updated information for the new Nature center and Pheasant Exhibits. The Zoological Society is hoping to have plans for the deer shelter approved and constructed later this summer. The next Master plan meeting will be held June 27th at the Highway Department conference Room at 6:30.

Discuss Dana Farm Project:

Dave updated the committee on the status of the Dana Farm project with the Farm Technology Days group.

Director's Report June 12th, 2019

Bruemmer Park

Mike and the summer crew are working hard to clean up the hiking trails around the park. We will be tackling the trail segment opposite of the fishing parking lot by the bridge next...just have to deal with some very large patches of poison ivy. The hunting and fishing club is replacing the old fencing on their pen – that project should be finishing up within the next couple of weeks. The zoo group is getting estimates back for the new goat/deer pen and we should have some updates on this project at their next meeting on June 27th.

Winter Park

Disc Golf is back and running. We have had to have the club move the basket on the tubing hill to a different location in the woods to help prevent disc golfers from hitting the buildings and the magic carpet. The disc golf club is also working on updating their signs and they are getting the course cleaned up. We still have a lot of muddy areas on the ski hill to deal with so we are working around that the best we can. Other projects here have involved minor landscaping around the magic carpet and we will be working on expanding the parking lot – Winter Park Association will be covering those costs.

Ryan Park

The soccer season has started and the park has been busy. The hiking trails have been cleared of trees/debris from the last storm by our staff and the mountain bike trails have been also been taken care of by our small group of volunteers. We will be looking at cleaning the cedar siding on the restroom building and staining...we just need some dry weather.

Krohns Lake

The Highway Dept. has replaced the roof on the bathroom building and replaced the boardwalk leading to the building. With this work done we will be completing out some of our outstanding grants at this location. We have had some minor vandalism, have had to grade the parking lot numerous times due to burn outs and have had tables thrown in the lake. The crew will be installing the swim raft at this location within the next couple of weeks.

West Alaska Lake

Highway has brought in some new stone and top soil so we could repair some vehicle damage to the lawn and parking/drive areas. We also added some boulders around the new electrical box and picnic space at this location.

Red River Park

We were able to repair the soft spot in the roadway at the park. Still awaiting a timeframe from Highway for the paving work to start. We also had to have Highway clear the road after the severe storms that hit the shoreline 3 weeks ago left a lot of debris and logs in the park.

Fairgrounds

Highway repaired some fencing surrounding the race track last week – fencing was leaning towards the bandstand, cause is most likely frost heave. We are scheduled to have our 7th race of the season this upcoming Friday. Attendance has been spotty early on, but the promoter tells us that the last race had increased numbers in the stands. Hopefully Mother Nature cooperates this week!

Ahnapee Trail

The next batch of signs have been ordered to finish up the sign project from Casco to Algoma. A few of the new signs posts have been damaged over the winter months by vehicles and will be replaced as needed. The Highway Dept. will be repairing/redecking the bridge near Reckelberg over the next week or two and we will also be working with CTI in Algoma on the parking lot/property swap at that location. We also will be adding some new picnic tables to the Highway M parking lot in Algoma thanks to a grant we obtained with the Friends of the Ahnapee Trail group.

Dana Farm

I will be meeting with the Farm Tech Days committee later this month to continue discussion of the project at the Dana Farm. Estimates and designs are coming in for the new building and for the repairs to the Ransom Moore cabin.
