1). **Call to Order:** Meeting called to order at 8:15 AM by Chairman Charles Wagner

- a. *Animal Waste Storage Permits:* No Animal Waste Permits, but Ebert's Enterprises has received a permit under the Kewaunee County Agricultural Waste & Process Wastewater Irrigation Ordinance for irrigation of feed leachate/feed pad precipitation runoff (process wastewater) and solid separated manure liquids in Section 6 of Pierce Township.
- b. *Farmland Preservation/Standards and Prohibitions Walkovers:* April/May – Travis conducted 31 walkovers (3195 acres). 27 were in full compliance and 4 received a schedule of compliance for erosion, tillage setbacks, manure storage (needed).
